Notice to Players

The Rules of the United States Golf Association and, where applicable, the following Conditions and Local Rules govern play.

- 1) **Format:** Stroke play over 54 holes. Split tees on all three days are anticipated, starting from #1 and #10.
- 2) **TIES:** Senior Men Championship and Women Senior Championship winners will be determined by sudden death playoff starting on hole #1. All other ties will be determined by USGA Appendix I(C)3(c).
- 3) **Divisions:** Men Senior Championship, Men Senior 1st and 2nd flights, Men Super Senior, Women Senior Championship, Women 1st flight
Men Masters, Men Adult
- 4) **Tees:** Men Senior from WHITE tees, Men Super Senior from GOLD tees, Women Senior from RED tees, Men Masters and Adult from BLUE tees
- 5) **Awards:**
 - Men Senior State Amateur Champion from Men Senior Championship flight
 - Women Senior State Amateur Champion from Women Senior Championship flight
 - Awards for low gross and low net Men Senior flights, Men Super Senior flights
 - Awards for low gross and low net Women Senior flightsAwards for low gross and low net Men Masters and Men Adult
NOTE: Luncheon on final day will BEGIN approximately 30 min. after first groups finish
- 6) **Ground under repair:** Any deemed GUR has been marked with signage or white lines. Only the Committee is authorized to mark or otherwise designate any other areas as ground under repair.
- 7) **DROP ZONE:** While playing Hole #4, for a ball in a hazard, an additional option is a DROP ZONE
- 8) **OUT OF BOUNDS:** Boundary fences and white stakes make out of bounds, including hole #7 while playing hole #4
- 9) **Stones in bunkers** are movable obstructions (Rule 24-1 applies)
- 10) **Hazards:** Red stakes or lines LATERAL WATER HAZARD. Yellow stakes or lines, WATER HAZARD.
- 11) **Distance Measuring Devices:** A player may obtain distance information by using a device that measures distance only. However, if, during a stipulated round, a player uses a distance measuring device that is designed to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect their play (e.g., gradient, wind-speed, temperature, etc.) the player is in breach of Rule 14-3, for which the penalty is **disqualification**
- 12) **Doubt as to Procedure:** Rule 3-3 authorizes play of a second ball when doubtful of your rights or procedure. After the situation which caused the doubt has arisen and before taking any further action, you must announce to your marker your decision to precede under Rule 3-3 and which ball you will score with if the Rules permit. Upon completing the round (and **prior to signing your scorecard**) you must report the facts immediately to the Committee. The penalty for failing to do so is **disqualification**.
- 13) **Pace of Play:** Rules committee has the discretion to assess penalty for slow play. Please keep up with group in front of you.
- 14) **Cell phones** shall not be used by competitors or their caddies during the stipulated round. Only exception being for rules clarifications or emergency. Please be courteous to your competitor. Willful violation may result in a 2-stroke penalty (stroke play)
- 15) **Scoring Area:** inside clubhouse in designated area
